Last summer Andrea (daughter of BLF missionaries, Mike and Laura Jensen) participated in her "first ever mission's adventure". Under the auspices of Youth With A Mission, Andrea spent three weeks in Belgium, Luxembourg and England with a church group, for the purpose of reaching other youth with the Gospel.

She writes... *After preparation and training in Hacht, Belgium, we began street evangelism in Brussels, using drama, dance and testimonies. Then we went to Luxemburg City and did a prayer walk around its walls. Please pray for that city. While there I saw many young people getting drunk, high and stoned in the parks. It's a shock and very sad. From there we went to Plymouth, England to set up a kid's program. We worked in the worst part of Plymouth known as Barnbarton. Many of the kids have only one parent, or parents who are alcoholics, and the kids take care of themselves. On the last day one of the older and more popular boys gave his life to Christ. It is a huge answer to prayer. Please pray for him.*
